## Who won a C.A.S.E. in court?

The Office's Annual Employee Recognition Program offers the opportunity for staff to win a different kind of CASE in court

The reason being is C.A.S.E., which stands for Celebrating And Saluting Employees, is an annual recognition program that is held to recognize the outstanding efforts of staff ... and the once-a-year time to hear who won their C.A.S.E. is happening now in the Office.

This month, five C.A.S.E. Award ceremonies were held where more than **160 staff members** were presented an award for either an outstanding performance in Customer Service, Leadership, Excellence, or Teamwork. The CHI was originally created to show the yearly growth percentage for cases filed with the Clerk of the Court's Office, but it evolved to include some historical information, and provide location and access information, as well as summary figures for each case category. 
## What is the latest on the Southeast Adult and Juvenile renovation work?

Phase I of the **SEA Remodel Project** will be completed within the next month, with the new file counter tentatively opening on **Monday, July 29**. The public will immediately benefit from expanded service capacity, with the new SEA File Counter offering **17 service windows and seven public access terminals**.

Phase II of the SEA remodel will start shortly after, in early August. This phase includes the build-out of a dedicated Courtroom Services workspace, an expanded multi-purpose room, an upgraded breakroom, and guest offices. Phase II is estimated to be complete by **October 2024**. The photos to the right show the finishing touches being applied at SEA.

The **SEJ renovation**, which started in late 2023, is a considerably more expansive project. To accommodate the evolving needs of Juvenile Court, the entire two-story interior has been razed to accommodate the new space design. Despite the large scope of this remodel, SEJ is tentatively scheduled to re-open by the **summer of 2025**.

## Office three-peats winning County's Security Challenge

For the third year in a row, the Clerk's Office won Maricopa County's **Cyber Security Awareness Challenge**. The Challenge is held to help increase the overall technology security awareness for county employees. The Clerk's Office was the winner for having the most participants in the Challenge in the "Large Department" category (over 500 staff). As a result, the Office will be receiving a trophy. The County Air Quality Unit finished first for "Medium-Sized" departments, and the Clerk of the Board finished first for "Small-Sized" departments.



## The Old Courthouse turns 95 this month

The 95th Anniversary of the opening of the Old Courthouse (OCH) is this month. The OCH opened in 1929. Currently, the Clerk's Office has courtroom clerks who work in the building. In 2018, the Office's Probate Office moved out of the building, which ended the Office having an actual departmental presence within the building perhaps since it first opened.


